Surveying worlds from lofty heights and haze.



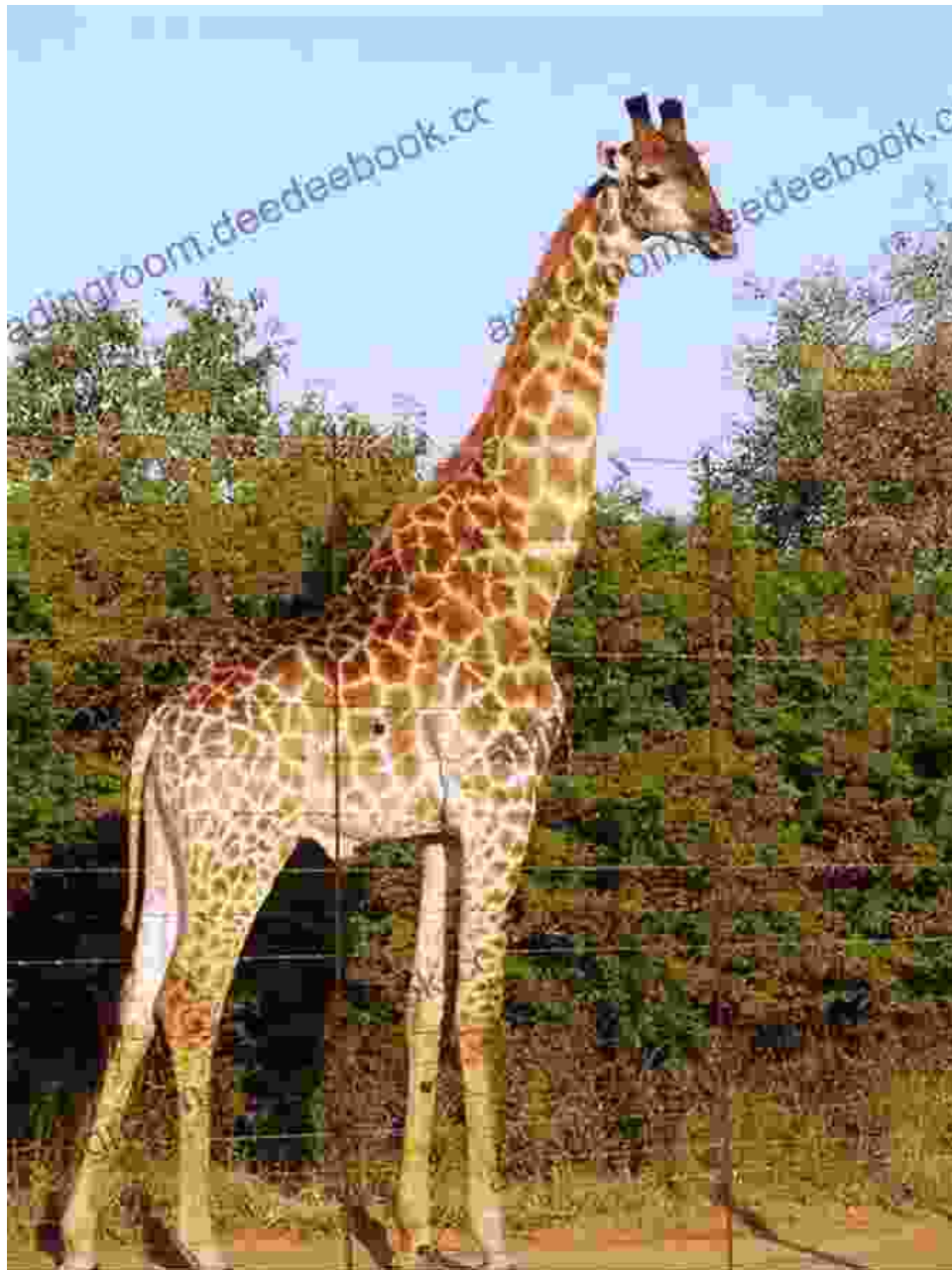
5. The Dolphin's Graceful Dance

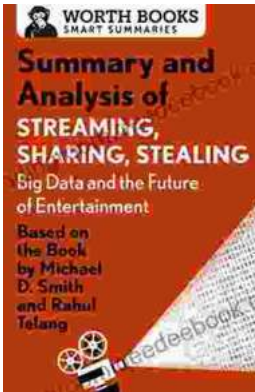

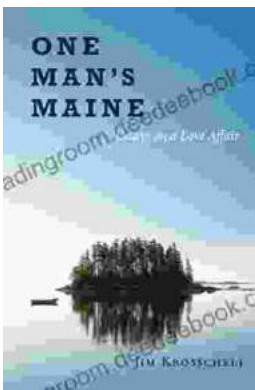
