

All Straight and Box Pick Pick and Straight Pick Lottery Numbers

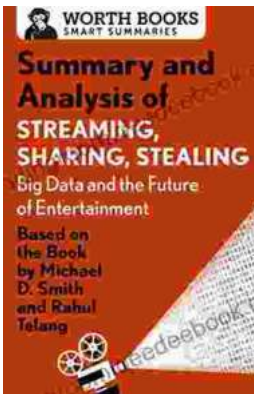

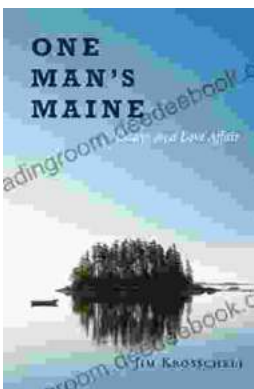
