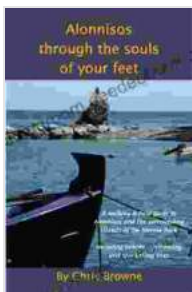

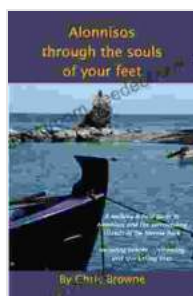
How to Get to the Alonnisos Marine Park

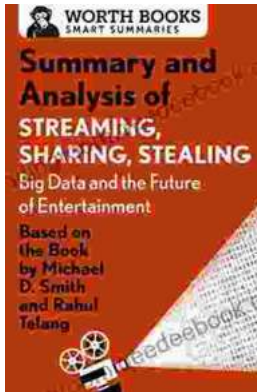

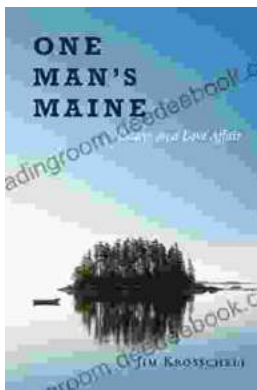
